Brick-by-Brick" is a Polyform . . . its five pieces contain all the possibilities for combining three rectangular blocks together in staggered layers.



Puzzle purists and mathematicians like this kind of puzzle because the rules are simple and complete but lead to a wealth of possibilities.

To play Brick-by-Brick," simply combine the five pieces to form symmetrical walls.

To get you going, we've included a set of cards to show some of the walls that are possible. Once you've mastered our patterns, go out and create your own.

As you play Brick-by-Brick,"
we hope you see how fresh
and creative it is. Each solution,
when you reach it, seems to jump
out of nowhere... but it seems obvious
once it appears.



- **1.** Complete walls must be symmetrical, with the same profile left and right.
- Individual bricks must overlap between layers, like a real brick wall.
